Inform your academic advisor of your interest in study abroad.
Search ISUAbroad for programs in the country/area of the world you are interested in living in for several months.
Set up an appointment to discuss various study abroad opportunities with Jessica Boertje from the CALS Study Abroad Office in 0018 Curtiss Hall.
Narrow down your search. Look at the courses available for the semester you plan to study abroad at the host institution, found under the "Academics" tab.
Check course options with your academic advisor by bringing your ideal class list to your advisor and have them determine how the courses will transfer back to lowa State for you.
Apply for a program(s) in ISUAbroad
Complete host institution application . Each international university will require you to complete their application after you have been nominated by ISU.
Commit to the program once the host institution has accepted you and your ISUAbroad application is changed to "Accepted" click the "Commit" button. Fill in the post-decision material and let your adventure begin!
